

## FCSC BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS

In-person voting 7PM, Wed. Jan. 9

Mail-In ballot receipt cut off: 1/9, Noon (Turners Falls, POB)

Hand delivered ballot cut-off Wed. 1/9, FCSC Clubhouse.  
(Place envelope in Visitor Waiver/fee box; voter's name must be in the envelope and will only be used to check off on membership list)

Election Night Raffle and 50-50 Raffle

Voting was designed to make the Club inclusive. A shortage of candidates takes away competition for office, but vote counting creates consensus and endorsement.

Write-ins are accepted. Mark a write-in with an X

Without an "X" no vote is recorded for the candidate.

All Adult members of the club may vote. If you did not get enough ballots, copy the ballot and mark the returned ballot "F" for family. Family ballots must be received together and each vote marked separately.

If you vote by mail or drop-off, you may not vote again on election night. You may participate in the raffles and socialize.

Ballots are counted Wed., 1/9, announced at the meeting, and posted on the website.
